Sub: 18th SET Project Registration

The online link for the registration for the 18th Science, Engineering and Technology (SET) Project by the post graduate students will be made available from **10-02-2020 (Monday) to 12-02-2020 Wednesday**.

Project guide

During the registration completion process, the details of the project guide and the tentative project title need to be included. The students are required to take prior consent from the guide, before entering the details. No change of guide will be permitted after the registration. The registration is deemed to be complete only if the faculty guide accepts the registration request of the student through their login.

Processes

Detailed evaluation metrics followed, weightages at different stages, key dates for various project milestones are given in the Annexure.

Plagiarism check

In order to maintain uniformity, the SET conference research report should be written in a specific format that will be made available through the SET coordinators of the respective programmes. The research document will be subjected to plagiarism check, before the submission of the photo-ready document. Not more than 12% of plagiarism is permitted (as per Turnitin software) for the submitted final SET conference document.

Grades

Successful completion of the SET project will result in a letter grade. As per the regulations, absolute grading methodology will be followed for the SET project. **Failure to identify a topic and guide before 12-02-2020 (Wednesday) will result in an 'N' grade in the SET project.** As per regulations, a student receiving 'N' or 'F' grade need to register for an additional programme elective course in the subsequent semester so as to meet their graduation credit requirements.

Conference Dates

The 18th SET Conference will be held on **30-03-2020 (Monday)** and **31-03-2020 (Tuesday)** and will be hosted by School of Electrical Engineering (SELECT). UG Students / Research Scholars who have not made any online registration can also participate in the SET Conference directly and publish a paper.
